



# Sharon Wandler Scholarship

In 2018, The Yakima Housing Authority established the Sharon Wandler Scholarship in memory of Sharon Lee Wandler, who served 24 dedicated years as the Finance Director at the Yakima Housing Authority. Three scholarships will be awarded, with each receiving \$1,000 and two exemplary applications receiving an additional \$1,000. The scholarship will be awarded to candidates pursuing their first degree.

The YHA Scholarship Committee, will accept and review the scholarship applications and determine the scholarship amount awarded. The Scholarship Committee awards scholarship funds directly to the accredited institution of higher education once proof of registration at the college or university is received.

The rules, procedures and application are below. Please read the rules and application very carefully. If you have any questions, please call the YHA office at (509) 453-3106, extension 114.

## Rules and Procedures

### Eligibility

1. Scholarship applications are made available to eligible individuals in good standing with YHA.
2. Eligible individuals are current or past tenants, Section 8 voucher residents, and federal/state funded rental assistance residents living in a household or being provided a service managed by YHA.
3. Eligible individuals must be a graduating high school senior, or possess a high school diploma or GED, applying to or attending an accredited institution of higher education. If currently attending college, applicant must be registered for at least two (2) classes.

### Application Process

1. The application must be reviewed and evaluated by a representative selected by the Executive/Deputy Director. To be considered complete, all sections of the application must be filled out. If a section is not applicable, put N/A (not applicable) in the area; do not leave any areas blank. An application that is blank or missing appropriate submittals or signatures will be disqualified

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2. The application must include letters of recommendation on character such as a representative from a community organization, employer, and an academic reference (only non-relative recommendations will be considered).
  3. The application must include an unofficial transcript of grades from high school or academic institution presently attending (transcript may be forwarded separate from application but must postmarked by deadline).
  4. The applicant must include verification of acceptance/attendance to a specific school.
  5. The application must include an essay (up to two pages) written by the student that details their educational plans & goals and describe your community service or engagement activities. *Essays showcasing outstanding community engagement may be selected for additional financial awards.*
  6. Screening, evaluation, and selection conducted by the Scholarship Committee.  
**Applicants must submit their application to the designated representative, who will submit to the Scholarship Committee for consideration of the scholarship.**
- \* Upon award, a high-resolution photo of the Scholarship recipient may be requested.**

1. Three scholarships, each receiving \$1,000 and two exemplary applications receiving an additional \$1,000, will be awarded and paid directly to the accredited institution of higher education.
